Unofficial strike in Horsens



For the third consecutive day, there is a strike in Horsens. Tuesday and Wednesday 200 employees from the primal cutting, forends and the killing-butcher line went on strike, but Thursday only 60 choose to continue the strike.

The strike is due to a bonus system which is introduced in another big Danish slaughterhouse business. The bonus system means, that the company employees in the primal cut are paid by the hour according to the period of collective agreement.

- It is very strange that the employees in Horsens have chosen to strike due to an agreement, that another company has introduced. Danish Crown have not challenged the common understanding of killing-butchery line, line, convoy belt and packaging since 2012, and Danish Crown do not have any plans of doing so, says Søren F. Eriksen, CEO, Danish Crown Pork.

- We have informed the employees, that we guarantee, that we will not challenge the common understanding of killing-butchery line, line, convoy belt and packaging in the period of collective agreement, says Søren F. Eriksen.

He emphasizes that Danish Crown is in no way entitled to or able to interfere in the process currently running in another company.

- I therefore encourage everyone to go to work again, because it is not an agreement that concerns Danish Crown, says Søren F. Eriksen.
